

Since September 2019, a new space for events is available, with capacity for approximately 100 people, prepared to host private or corporate events, with a dedicated kitchen and bar.

Full Day in Lisbon, Sintra & Estoril Coast

This city is linked with the heroic deeds of the Portuguese maritime exploration, in the 15th and 16th centuries. This was the Age of Discoveries and the Golden Era of Portugal, transforming Lisbon into the opulent center of a vast empire. Part of the wealth from these expeditions was used to build magnificent monuments in a unique

Portuguese style: the extravagant Manueline architectural style, best typified in **Jerónimos Monastery**. Some of these monuments can still be seen, especially in the area of Belém.

This tour will also take you on a journey exploring the best Portuguese royal residences with the relaxing views of the Portuguese seaside. The first stop will be in the **World Heritage Site of Sintra** where hundreds of years of history and culture await you. Doing a short walk in the **old city center** you'll find yourself surrounded by the old houses now converted into small quaint handicraft shops and traditional pastry shops. Driving around the mountain you will pass by amazing **Royal Palaces, Chalets and Aristocratic residences** in the most incredible combination of architectural styles, colors, and shapes that you will find in Portugal.

After a nice lunch break, the return to Lisbon will follow a very special road named "Marginal" by the Portuguese running always parallel to the **white sandy beaches** and amazing **17th-century fortresses** starting at the town of **Estoril** with its famous casino.

Évora



The winding **walled city of Évora**, capital of the Alentejo region is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and will enchant you with its medieval appearance. It will be difficult to stop walking around the very narrow streets of its historical center.

Besides several other monuments to be visited (such as the **Cathedral**, **Saint Francis church**, and the ancient **University**), it is also in Évora that one of the most significant traces of the Roman occupation in Portuguese territory is located: The **Roman Temple**, from the 1st century and probably dedicated to the Emperor Augusto but famous under the name of **Diana's temple** (name associated with the goddess of the hunters).

Take the chance to have lunch here, since Évora – like any other genuine city in Alentejo – is well known for its fantastic **traditional gastronomy**. A "meeting" with Portuguese history and the authentic houses from the South of Portugal, with their whitewashed façades.

Wine Tasting Cartuxa



About this experience:

The Cartuxa winery house is located in Quinta de Valbom, 2km from the historical center of Évora. This property has belonged to the Jesuits until the XVIII century. In 1759, Marquis de Pombal expelled the Jesuits from Portugal and the property start to belong to the Portuguese Estate. During this period, this property was very important for the region's economy due to the wine's production. In the 19th century, Eugénio de Andrade Family acquired this property and made several works to expand the estate, preserving the original design of the secular building. It will be in this environment that you will be able to visit Cartuxa, and understand the wine production of one of the most important wines of the Alentejo region. At the end of the visit you will have a wine tasting. Enjoy...



About the Restaurant:

The Restaurant Fialho began by being a "tasca", founded by Manuel Fialho in 1948, with the cooperation of his children. In the beginning of the fifties it began to serve tidbits and some plates of traditional "alentejana" food, of simple but careful making and having an already reasonable list of wines. It was in the decade of 1960' that were introduced remodeling and enlargement works that checked part of the actual draws of the Restaurant. This remodeling (1965) was under the responsibility of Architect Ruy Couto and to the civil builder from Évora, Romeu Mendes. The decade of 80 marked a new phase of great prestige in the life of the restaurant with honorable presences in the exterior, having been recognized by then the work done on behalf of the defense and conservation of the Regional Kitchen Alentejana.



Marialva



Marialva is one of the so-called **Historical Villages of Portugal**, still preserving its medieval look, surrounded by stone walls. This place had a significant military importance due to its **geographical situation** of altitude and proximity to the border.

A few minutes from the city of **Mêda**, this Historical Village reveals a scene of **authentic relics of the Portuguese ancestry**, transporting the visitor to the deepest roots of the country's history. The streets, flanked by weather-resistant buildings, lead to the city surrounded by walls in whose ruins is easy to lose track of time.

Settled by the Aravos, the Lusitanian people, it was later conquered by the Romans, followed by the Arabs, until the final victory of D. Fernando, the Magno, in 1063, in its emblematic conquest of the Beiras.

Douro Valley



The **Douro Valley** is definitely one of the most spectacular areas Europe when it comes to scenery. The calm waters of the river Douro provide just the right amount of humidity for the famous **Port wine grapes** to grow and mature.

On the steep slopes of the river banks, over 2000 years ago, the Romans decided to plant thousands of hectares of vineyards, creating terraces on each corner of the valley making it a paradise for wine lovers.



Quinta da Pacheca



**About this experience:**

Set on the banks of the river Douro, the Quinta da Pacheca is one of the best known estates in the Douro region. It was also one of the first properties to bottle wine under its own label. It is first mentioned in a document dated from April 1738 making it one of the oldest as well! It was only in 1903 that the Serpa Pimental family decided to dedicate their efforts to the risky business of winemaking and, nowadays, one century and many successes later, the same family keeps on making the same wonderful wines as they did in the past, with all the expertise of one century producing wine. Maria do Céu Gonçalves and Paulo Pereira bought the estate in 2012, starting a new era of expansion and vitality. Nowadays, the winemaking of Pacheca's wines, for limited annual production of Douro DOC wines and special categories of Port Wines only, is under the orientation of winemaker Maria Serpa Pimentel and the agronomist Hugo Fonseca. As soon as you cross the estate's imposing gate you will be welcomed and invited to visit the property, as well as the old wine cellars, where you'll learn more about the varieties and characteristics of Quinta da Pacheca's portfolio wines, which the winemaker Maria Serpa Pimentel keeps improving with respect for the family's passion. . At the end there will be a wine tasting waiting for you and you will be able to try some of their ports and, naturally, some of their table wines. The visit will start and end in the old stables, where the Wine Shop is today..



Welcome to Porto!




As soon as you arrive in **Porto**, you'll understand how diversified Portugal is, although being a quite small country. Considered the second largest Portuguese city, Porto is completely different from Lisbon, in terms of size, colors, traditions and even in what concerns the local population. On the north bank of Douro River, the city of Porto is still one of the most impressive Portuguese cities, having still nowadays a certain feeling of rivalry towards Lisbon.

The riverside **quarter of Ribeira** is a delightful site, with its narrow streets, typical houses and picturesque lifestyle. It has been recently restored, now including some fashionable restaurants and bars. In the city center, you can have a look at some of the most significant monuments (**Stock Exchange Palace, St. Francis Church and Clérigos Church and Bell Tower**) and also go to the commercial and pedestrian street of **St. Catherine**.

On the other bank of Douro River (at Vila Nova de Gaia) we advise you to visit one of the **Port Wine cellars**, including some Port Wine tasting at the end. The historical center of this city is a World Heritage site (classified by UNESCO in 1996).

Half Day in Porto



Its inhabitants are proud to be "tripe eaters" and they call their city the "unbeatable". It is a fact that the city of Porto has been the stage for some of the most important historical and cultural events that still today mold the Portuguese culture.

During this tour, you will be able to experience all the charm and history of **Porto**. Once you reach the **historical city center**, considered **World Heritage by UNESCO**, you will have more than enough time to explore the **Church of São Francisco**. This old simple gothic Franciscan church is now known as "**the cave of gold**" in an astonishing exhibit of wealth and power. Right next door you'll find the **Stock Exchange Palace** with incredible granite work and magnificent neo-Arab influences. On your way up to the Cathedral, you'll still have time to admire the interesting glazed tiles of the **São Bento Railway station**. After a visit to the **Cathedral** (12th century), you will be able to admire the river Douro and all of the **Port Wine lodges** that brought fame and fortune to the city.

Everything is perfectly accompanied with a wide selection of craft beers with special emphasis on Sovina, the drink of the house.

You'll wander among old Roman ruins, **Romanesque** and **Manueline churches** at the same time you stroll across its commercial busy area. Don't miss the **Santa Cruz Church** with the tombs of the two first **kings of Portugal** (Afonso Henriques and Sancho I).


