Egypt – Sept 23-Oct 2 – 4N Cairo/ 4N Nile Cruise

See Cairo and the Great Pyramids, then head down the Nile to Johnny Carson's favorite temple – Karnak, hit Luxor, swing by the Valley of the Kings where King Tut "lives", and end up at the Nile dams in Aswan. We have four nights in Cairo and four nights on the Nile cruise.
